Piano Tuition Policies

Thank you for looking into my services. It is my pleasure to be working with you.

Please have a read through my Terms and Conditions prior to making your enquiry.

- Piano lessons may be paid for via cash, card or bank transfer upon request of an invoice. Payments by card are priced slightly higher as they include a transaction fee.
- As of the last review date of this document, the price of a standard piano lesson is £20 for a 30 minute lesson or £36 for a full hour.
- The first lesson between myself and a pupil is always a taster lesson. A taster lesson costs £10 for 15 minutes, following which the prices above come into effect.
- If you do not pay for a lesson at the time, you will need to pay no later than the next lesson for both lessons. If you do not, no further lessons will be offered until payment has been received.
- In the event of absence that has not been / is not paid for, upcoming lessons may be cancelled until a suitable resolve can be met.
- If you can no longer attend for a lesson, I ask that you cancel min. 48 hours prior to guarantee no charge. Within 48 hours will be treated circumstantially.
- Late arrival may result in having no lesson or a shortened lesson that will still be charged at the standard amount as above.
- Please note there is no waiting area at my house.
 Please arrive on time and arrange to be picked up as necessary at the time of your lesson's end.

- Please do not park on the driveway unless this has been prearranged and avoid parking on Congleton Road. The best place to park is on Moss View Road.
- My tuition is one on one. I cannot provide joint lessons, however there is space for one parent / guardian to sit in on the lesson if needed.
- Lessons over bank holidays or over the weekend are not offered as a rule, but it remains nonetheless at my discretion. If I offer you this service, it may be at a higher rate.
- My fees may increase annually to account for inflation. You will be notified in advance in this event.
- My pupils should be willing to honour a practice routine with a minimum number of hours per week. This may change pupil to pupil but we will work on them together.
